

## **How to become a certified mead judge?**

To become a certified mead judge, one must meet several basic criteria.

1. In first instance you need to register for the exam or by taking part in one of the MJP training courses and passing a exam.
2. To pass this test you need to acquire at least 70% of possible points.
3. After passing a theoretical test you will be entitled to take a practical exam (within 52 weeks from passing on-line test).
4. The price of exam depends on the exam date and place. Exams usually takes place in small groups of participants in previously set date and place. In some extraordinary circumstances there is a possibility of taking an exam remotely.
5. Practical exam consists of judging at least 5 samples of mead using MJP scoring sheets. The score of 70% and above will be equivalent to passing an exam and gaining a title and certificate of MJP mead judge.
6. There are possibilities to take an exam for certain judge levels:
  - a) In regional language for Level 1 (national judge)
  - b) In English for Level 2 (international judge)
7. After gaining a title, a mead judge will receive their unique number, MJP badge showing their specific level and a certificate.
8. Gaining a judge qualification is also We would love to see you joining mead judges community.
